Choosing Colours for Your Kitchen

Choosing the right colour for your kitchen is an important part of your renovation. The following guidance from Silas7 is designed to help you make confident choices and achieve a kitchen that looks exceptional and performs beautifully for everyday life.

Consider the Light in Your Home

Light levels vary greatly in UK homes and can significantly affect how colours appear.

Kitchens with limited natural light often suit warmer neutrals and softer tones

Bright, south-facing kitchens can accommodate cooler or deeper colours

We recommend viewing your chosen colour card in your kitchen at different times of day.

Think Long Term

A kitchen is a long-term investment. Many Silas7 customers choose:

Timeless neutral colours for main cabinetry

Bolder or darker colours for islands, tall units or feature areas

This approach keeps the space versatile while allowing personality and contrast.

Worktops, Flooring & Surrounding Finishes

Cabinet colours should work in harmony with other surfaces:

Warm timber or stone flooring pairs well with cream, beige and warm grey tones

Cool tiles or concrete finishes complement cooler greys and muted colours

Heavily patterned or bold worktops are best balanced with simpler cabinet colours

Where possible, we recommend selecting flooring and worktops before finalising cabinet colours.

Accents & Hardware

Smaller details help bring the design together:

Handles, taps and appliances introduce contrast and texture

Black, brushed brass or stainless steel finishes can subtly change how a cabinet colour appears

Your chosen cabinet colour should complement these elements rather than compete with them.

Natural Wood & Painted Finishes

Combining painted cabinetry with natural timber adds warmth and depth.

Timber works beautifully on islands, pantries or open shelving

Lighter woods create a modern, airy feel

Darker woods add richness and contrast

This balance often results in a refined, high-end finish.


